If you wish to be contacted on a different number please email the School Office with this information no later than 12noon on the day of your appointment, so that we can inform the relevant Teacher.

Please also kindly note that we request that the conversation held with your Teacher is not in the presence of your child/ren as it is important for us that we have an opportunity to speak to you separately about your child/rens progress and overall wellbeing. Thank you.
