

Each Telephone Consultation will last for 10 minutes. Your child's Class Teacher will ring you at the time of your appointment on the telephone number linked to your School Gateway account.

We will be sending out information on how to book an appointment in the next couple of weeks. **Please look out for an email notification from the School Office giving booking instructions.**

CANCELLATION OF 2021 NATIONAL CURRICULUM ASSESSMENTS (SATs)

The Government have notified primary schools that the Key Stage Two (Year 6) SATs due to take place in May 2021 have been cancelled this year. All Key Stage One (Year 2) assessments and the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check scheduled for the summer term have also been cancelled. Schools will continue to use assessment to inform teaching, to enable them to give information to parents on their child's attainment and to support transition of Year 6 pupils to secondary school.
