Dear Shellingford School Family,

Our Year 5/6 pupils have had a fantastic time this week at Yenworthy Lodge in North Devon. The residential is always a highlight of their time at Shellingford and we have been so impressed with their attitudes, teamwork and willingness to try many new challenging outdoor activities.

#### HARVEST CELEBRATIONS

Over the next two weeks we will be reflecting on the value of 'Generosity' in our Collective Worship as we approach harvest. Our whole school **Harvest Service is next Friday 1**<sup>st</sup> **October at St Faith's church** and will be led by the children in Classes 1 and 2 and the Reverend Max Young.

In light of COVID-19, we have had to carefully consider the size of the church and space available for parents now that the school has significantly increased in number.

Therefore, sadly the decision has been made that **this service will be a school only act of worship** in order to continue to help keep the school and wider community safe.

This year we have decided to support **Fareshare**. FareShare is the UK's national network of charitable food redistributors, made up of independent organisations who take good quality surplus food from across the food industry and distribute it to frontline charities and community groups.

On **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> October** we will be holding a <u>Whole School Harvest Celebration Day</u>. This will be a **non-school uniform day** and we kindly ask every child to donate **£1.00** towards Fareshare.
