Dear Shellingford School Family,

Our thoughts continue to be occupied by the conflict in Ukraine and the ensuing refugee crisis. Regular prayers for the people of Ukraine are being said during our Collective Worships and we have given the children opportunities to discuss the situation with their teachers if questions have arisen. We are keen to organise a series of fundraising events over the next few months, to support the Ukrainian refugees as best we can.

Our first event will be a 'Peace Day', next Friday 25th March when the whole school will be thinking about 'What is Peace?'
