Curriculum

Our whole school topic this term has a focus on History, hence Class 3 and 4's visit to Warwick Castle and Class 1 and 2's visit to The Vale and Downland Museum earlier this week. We would appreciate anything you can do to promote this at home, such as modelling getting things wrong sometimes and showing how you learn from it! Diary Dates for the Summer Term

I have included some key dates at the end of this newsletter which you may like to add to your diary, details of which will follow as the term progresses. We will be celebrating The Queen's Platinum Jubilee the week before the May half-term to mark Her Majesty's historic reign of 70 years of service. School Uniform and equipment reminders

We would appreciate your support with the following:
