The Parents' questionnaire results show that:

64% (43 out of 67) of parents returned the form.

98% of parents stated that they would recommend Shellingford School to another parent.

The total number of responses for all statements showed that 90% were entirely positive (strongly agreed / agreed). 6% didn't know or was not applicable. Only 3% of the total responses were negative (disagreed).
